 - In December, we saw 19,430 clients in the Paterson Office. We currently have 7-8 security guards from UFC and 2-3 Sheriff Officers.
 - We have still not been able to utilize the X-ray machine for clients since we
 do not have an adequate number of officers to both secure the buildings
 and operate the machine.
 - b. Paterson Building (80 Hamilton Street)
 - The front staircase located at the main entrance of our Paterson Office becomes hazardous during rain and snow. The steps get wet and become very slippery. This has caused us to have to close the front entrance during inclement weather.
 - 2. Passaic Building (114 Prospect Street, Passaic, New Jersey)
 - Cubicles have been completed on the first and second floors. We are now requesting to move forward in adding cubicles to the third floor.
 We are requesting 10 cubicles for \$21,000.
