A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE HOURLY RATE FOR OUTSIDE LEGAL SERVICES COUNSEL

WHEREAS the Passaic County Board of Social Services requires the services of Legal Professionals for outside litigation, labor and other specialized legal matters; and
