## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE MEDICAID CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACT.

WHEREAS the Passaic County Board of Social Services requires the services of a Medicaid Consultant to assist, *inter alia*, in the implementation and alignment of the Board's Medicaid policies with those of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS the Passaic County Board of Social Services published, in compliance with the pubic contracts law, a Request for Proposal for submissions for Medicaid Consulting Services; and

WHEREAS The Request for Proposal (RFP) was returnable July 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS there was one (1) Proposal submission for Medicaid Consulting Services, received and opened on the return date of July 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS based on the submission of the proposal and qualifications set forth therein, the PCBSS awarded Perselay Associates, Inc. the contract via resolution at its August 18, 2022 Meeting, with an effective date of August 1,2022; and

WHEREAS the RFP provided an option to extend the Contract an additional three (3) months as necessary; and

WHEREAS the parties heretofore endeavor to extend the relationship as set forth herein an additional three (3) months; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Passaic County Board of Social Services hereby extends the Medicaid Consulting Services Contract, as set forth herein, to Perselay Associates, Inc.; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the extension shall be effective November 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023; and
